In the middle of October, our Medical camp drove 45 kms to reach Makdadev, Udaipur. The doctor saw the patients affected with fever, diarrhea, anemia, malnutrition. Cataract patients were screened and treated. About 140 patients were given free medicines and care.

In the last weekend of October our medical team left in the morning and drove for one and half hour through highway to reach the place known as Nevtalai village Jawar Mines, Udaipur. The doctor saw patients affected with HIV (counseled), tuberculosis, malnutrition, a lady with nasal polyp (advised for surgery), bronchitis, a child with rectal prolapsed (advised and referred) along with fever and cough. A woman with leucorrhea was healed. Nearby 130 patients were given medical care. Five Cataract patients were screened and will be operated freely in the hospital soon.
